FROM THE DESK OF FR. ALFONSE...

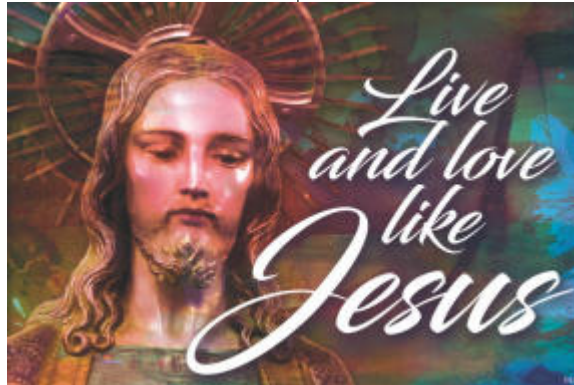


What is it worth to gain the whole world and lose your soul? What is it worth to live in a beautiful mansion, with a beautiful garden and an enormous swimming pool if I am alone? How sad it is! I have known people like that. I know too many

people like that. They are wealthy on the outside and poor, very poor, on the inside. It is not that I don't want to be rich. I do! But if I had to choose between being rich on the inside or on the outside, I would choose being rich on the inside - rich in what matters most! God is love and we were created in the image and likeness of God who is love. That means we were created to love and be loved. If I do not have love, I am nothing!

A smile is a confirmation – a signature – of happiness. So, are you smiling? Are you happy? If you are, then it's because you have experienced the Lord's blessing! 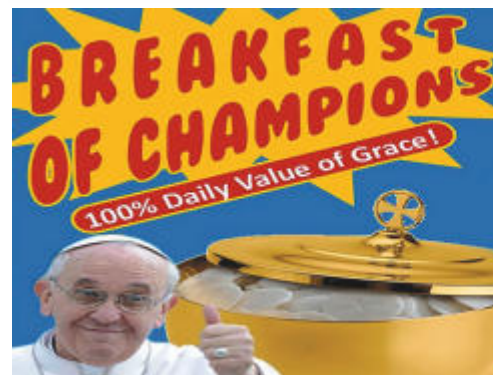

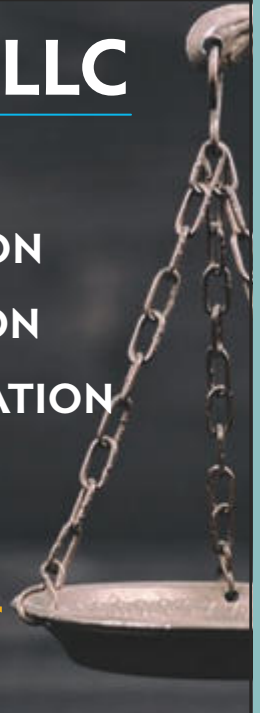
