

#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. ALFONSE...

Who will make you happy? Who will bring you peace? What will make you happy? What will bring you peace?

What is the secret? Allow the Lord to speak to you. He will, and it will be very loud and clear. Too often we tell the Lord what we want! Very infrequently do we ask the Lord what He wants? Too often do we place our trust in others! Not often enough do I place my trust in the Lord! Too often do we spend way too much time in front of the TV or computer! Not often enough do we spend time in front of the Blessed Sacrament or in Church.

Too often do we believe that our problems will be solved by our institutions! Not often enough do we believe that He alone is The Solution! Too often do I serve my neighbor! Not often enough do I serve the Lord.

What is the secret? It is simple. If I truly wish to follow, to love and to serve the Lord above all other things, then I must follow, love and serve the Lord. I must give the Lord the benefit of the doubt. I must give to Him what I owe to Him: my unconditional loyalty and love to Him. I must adore the Lord and no one else! I must make my heart an exclusive heart. I must "hate one and love the other."

What do you say when someone tells you, "Well done!" Do you say, "Thank you!" or do you say,

"Thanks be to God!" What do you say when someone looks up to you and says, "Look at all you have accomplished." Do you say, "That is so kind of you", or do you say, "Only by the grace of God!"

The secret to having more faith in God is to give God the credit that He deserves. If I do not, then I have made "dishonest wealth!" I am stealing from the Lord. I am taking what rightfully belongs to Him. Those of us who "steal" from the Lord usually end up looking for our happiness

and peace in all the wrong places!

Only the Lord can give us what is truly ours. Only the Lord can give our lives the sweetness, the excitement, the love and the peace we all desire. It will not come from this world. It will only come from above.

May we heed and observe carefully the words of our Lord. "You justify yourselves in the sight of others, but God knows your hearts; for what is of human esteem is an abomination in the sight of God."

Let us give to the Lord what is rightfully His so that He can give to us what is truly ours!



#### What is Stephen Ministry?

Stephen Ministry is a system through which members of All Saints are trained and organized to help provide Christian caregiving to members of our congregation and community. These ministers multiply the amount of caring ministry that All Saints can provide, by giving us a team of skilled caregivers who are equipped to bring Christ's healing love to people who are grieving, in crisis, or experiencing other stresses in life.

## Q: Is God calling you to become a Stephen Minister?

## A: The next training class will be forming in January!




